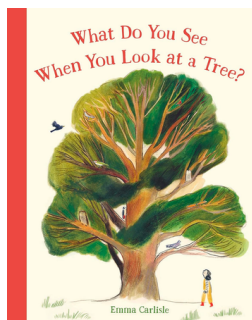

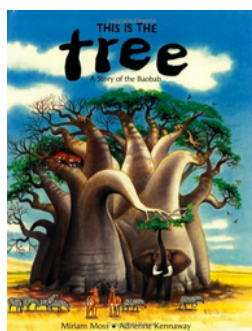

This is the Tree: Miriam Moss

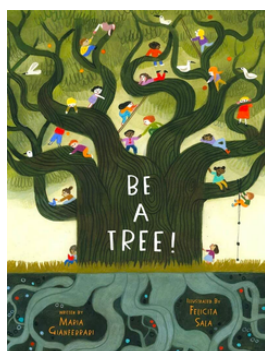
