| renewable resource | a sustainable source of energy that is not depleted when used |
|-----------------------|---|
| nonrenewable resource | an unsustainable source of energy that cannot be replenished when used due to its finite quantity available to humans |
| fossil fuels | coal, oil, and methane gas; natural resources that form over millions of years underground and can generate electricity when burned |
| solar power | the use of solar cells to convert sunlight into electricity |
| hydroelectric power | the use of water movement to generate electricity |
| wind power | the use of wind turbines to harness the energy of the wind and generate electricity |
| energy conservation | preventing wasteful uses of energy to insure its availability |
