

WORKSHOP OVERVIEW | ECOSYSTEM MOBILE


Overview:

When Change is Simple visited your classroom, we explored 3 different ecosystems: the arctic, the ocean, and the rainforest. You learned from our team of experts as they shared their knowledge of each of these amazing ecosystems. Now, you can become an expert on an ecosystem of your choice! In this activity, you will build an "ecosystem mobile" to share information on the different parts of your selected ecosystem.

Activity Duration: 60-90 min

ACTIVITY STEPS

- 1. Choose an ecosystem that you have not learned about from the list of 'Ecosystem Choices'.
- 2. Research your ecosystem. Try to learn about the plants, animals, non-living things, and endangered animals in your ecosystem. Most importantly, research the human impacts on your ecosystem and find out how people can help!
- 3. Gather your materials needed.
- 4. Label a wire hanger with the name of your ecosystem.
- 5. Hang pictures and descriptions of the six categories you researched. Check out the pictures below for examples!


