



life cycle the stages in which an object goes through from start to finish

natural resource something found in nature and is usually a raw material

raw material the original natural resource before being processed

limited something that is limited in quantity and will eventually run out

unlimited something that won't run out and is constantly being replenished

processing when raw materials are changed in order to make a product

manufacturing when materials are combined, shaped, and finalized to make a product

packaging when products are wrapped, boxed, or sealed in additional materials to ensure

their safety during travel

distribution when packaged products are transported by truck, planes, and cargo ships and

sent all around the world

usage how much of a particular product is used annually

disposal getting rid of a product in some way: trash, recycling, compost, etc.
