different times of the year that coincide with changes in weather and nature; seasons seasons are caused by the earth's orbit around the sun and tilt orbit a path that objects in space, like planets or moons, take as they go around another object, like the Sun the time it takes the earth to make one orbit around the sun, equal to 12 months year or 365 days winter the coldest season of the year when it snows in some places the season that comes after winter when the weather starts to get warmer spring summer the season when the weather is hot and sunny fall the season, also known as autumn, that comes after summer when the weather starts to cool down prediction a guess or estimation about what might happen in the future based on what we know or observe in the present
