

WORKSHOP OVERVIEW | ZAP! THREE IN A ROW



Overview:

Play 'ZAP!' Energy Bingo to review concepts your students learned with Change is Simple. Ask the students the questions provided. If they have the answer on their board, they get to mark that square. When someone has three in a row, ZAP! you have a winner! Print the cards or play 100% online!

Activity Duration: 30-45 minutes

ESSENTIAL QUESTIONS

- *How does your personal use of electricity relate to air pollution?*
- *How does the creation of energy for human use relate to climate change?*
- *Why does conserving energy at home and at school benefit personal and environmental health?*
- *How has technology changed our relationship with energy production and usage?*

MATERIALS NEEDED

- [ZAP! Energy Bingo](#)
- *Student computers OR printed bingo cards*



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Go to the [ZAP! Energy Bingo link](#) to open the game.
2. If using printed cards, print enough bingo cards for your class. If using the online version, select "Play online" at the top of the bingo card and share the URL provided there with your students. They can mark which squares have been called with bingo chips on paper boards or by selecting squares on the online board.
3. Once students are set up with their bingo boards, find the call list on the ZAP! page linked above. Read each question aloud to your students and keep track of which have been read. Click the cards to flip them over and see the correct answer. If students think they have the answer on their board, they should mark it off.
4. When someone thinks they have 3 in a row on their card, they should call out, "bingo!"
5. Keep playing for more bingos, time permitting.
