gyre a ringlike system of ocean currents rotating clockwise in the Northern

Hemisphere and counterclockwise in the Southern Hemisphere

single-use plastic plastic materials that are disposable and generally used only once before they

are thrown away

biodegrade materials that are capable to break down by living things
