



GREEN CHEMISTRY | VOCABULARY

<i>Green chemistry</i>	Making products using ingredients that are safe for the environment.
<i>Pollution</i>	Harmful substances that get into the air, water, or soil.
<i>Watershed</i>	An area where all the water drains into the same place.
<i>Runoff</i>	Water from rain that carries dirt and pollutants into rivers and lakes.
<i>Non-point source</i>	Pollution from many different places, like farms or cities
<i>Point source</i>	Pollution from one specific spot, like a factory or a pipe.
<i>Reservoir</i>	A natural or artificial lake or storage area where water is collected and stored
<i>Sustainable</i>	Doing things in a way that doesn't use up all Earth's resources and keeps it healthy for a long time.
